Contest Rules:

- 1) Anyone can participate. All participants must live near or around Fallbrook Ca or San Diego/Riverside Counties, or be willing to travel to these areas if chosen.
- 2) Participants must base their music on the lyrics, which accompany the Contest Entry Form. (Samples of written music will only be for the first verse and first chorus of the song.) Feel free to interpret these lyrics any way you'd like through the music, though there must be two versions of the song written per entry: a slower-paced country/pop or pop version and a faster-paced rock/Hard rock version. Music must be original and the property of the music writer upon entry. All entries must be accompanied by vocals.
- 3) When completed, convert both versions of the song (including music and vocals) into two .aif or mp3 files. Label these files with your name and style of music (example: JohnDoe_RockVersion.aif; JaneDoe_PopVersion.mp3). Burn both files onto one CD.
- 4) Send your completed CD and completed Contest Entry Form to:
admin@divinetrinityfilms.com Please email for snail mail address should your files be too large or you cannot scan in your entry form.
- 5) Deadline for entries is: October 13, 2007
- 6) There can only be one winner. Winner will be announced October 20, 2007.
- 7) Winning entry will become the sole property of the Fallbrook Film Factory. All original files (including, but not limited to, all written sheet music and all recorded files of original entry) must be supplied to the Fallbrook Film Factory once recording begins.
- 8) Winning writer must be available to write the music for the complete song (both versions) and will be invited to record the music in a standard recording studio through the Fallbrook Film Factory. If writer is part of a band, the band is also welcome to help record the music. Vocals will not be recorded by music writer or band. The winning writer (or band) will also participate as background extras on stage in the film to which the song will be featured. Credit on the film and CD and a copy of both a DVD of the film and a CD of the music will also be given to the winning writer upon completion of both.
